

## Final papers and publication to journals/search engines

Papers submitted to either 11<sup>th</sup> EEDAL or LS:17 conference are eligible for referencing and/or publication to SRJ-Q1 and SCOPUS referenced journals as follows (authors must make a single choice):

### LS:17 papers

**All papers shall be submitted by authors to IEEE Xplore to get individual DOI**

**The full process shall be finalized by the authors by October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022 (attention: Firm Deadline – no extension possible)**

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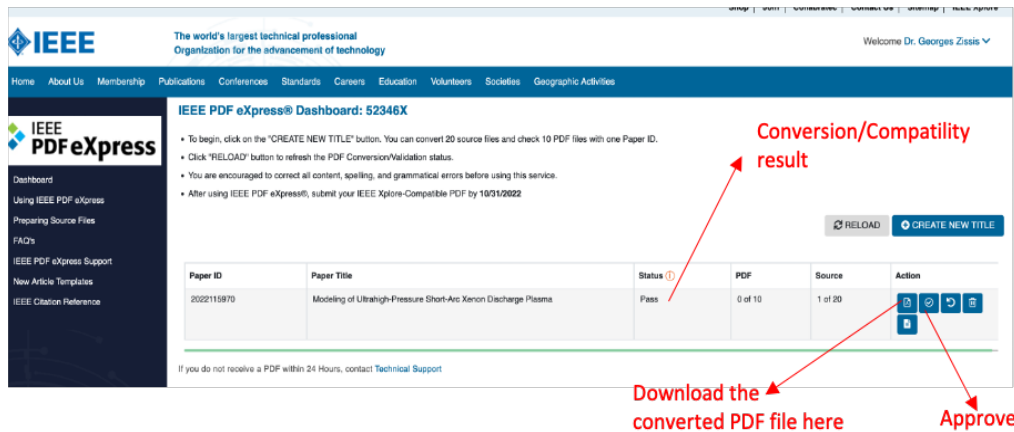
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12. The papers will appear in IEEE Xplore at the end of the full process at around mid-November.

**All papers listed to the IEEE Xplore are eligible and by invitation only, for republication to IEEE Transactions on Industry Applications (deadline June 2023)** - This journal applies the “present first – publish after” policy. The paper will pass again through peer review process and shall disclose explicitly that has been published to LS/EEDAL conference. Publication is free of charge (except if paper exceeds 12 printed pages)
